GHS CHEERLEADER GUIDELINES

EXPECTATIONS

- Cheerleaders must support the GHS Cheerleading Squad above all other teams.
- A candidate must be neatly presented, medically fit.
- No candidate shall be excluded based on gender or gender identity.
- Acceptance of a candidate shall be based on ability, the coach's agreement, and acceptance of squad rules.

MEMBERSHIP

- The GHS Cheerleader squad is a non-educational, extracurricular squad. The regular squad will consist
 of Varsity and a Junior Varsity squad with a set number of cheerleaders.
- The Varsity and JV squads will cheer at all respective football games and selected athletic contests (including showcase and pep rallies), participate in fundraisers, community and charity events unless otherwise stated, and participate in all competitions even if designated as an alternate.

ACADEMIC ELIGIBILITY

 Cheerleaders must maintain at least a 2.0 GPA average at the end of the semester to be eligible to participate in any athletic event. Participants not meeting this requirement will be dismissed.

BEHAVIOR

- Cheerleaders must uphold and maintain acceptable behavior throughout their service at GHS.
 Infractions such as teacher/administrative detentions and in-school suspension, are infractions that will be punished at the coach's discretion.
- Out of School suspension will result in automatic dismissal from the GHS cheerleading squad.
- All students must always abide by the School District of Lee County Student Code of Conduct.
- If a parent is disorderly to a coach your cheerleader could face the possibility of being removed from
 the team.
- The 24-Hour rule is in effect. All questions or concerns will be addressed not at the game, but the next day with a scheduled meeting.

Practice/Attendance/Events

- All practices and events are mandatory.
- To participate in practice, athletes must be in school for a minimum of 50% (4 periods) of that day.
- To participate in an event, athletes must be in school for the entire day of the event.
- Excused absences include serious injury, illness, family emergencies, class requirements, or a
 prearranged absence. A two-week advance notice for prearranged absences is required for events. A
 prearranged absence from practice requires a 48-hour notice.

DISMISSAL FROM OR QUITTING A CHEERLEADING SQUAD

 Anyone who is dismissed or chooses to quit a GHS cheerleading squad will be ineligible to tryout/cheer for any cheerleading squad the following school year.

IMPORTANT PARENT INFORMATION

Cheer Fees Agreement

- Each cheerleader is responsible for all costs associated with being a member of the GHS Cheerleading Squad.
- The estimated annual cost is \$750 per participant.
- Fundraisers will be held to help offset costs but the final responsibility for all costs lies with each participant.
- All funds raised by a participant will be put toward their total cheer balance owed.
- If your child makes the GHS cheerleading squad, members are responsible for the initial \$300.00 of the total balance. Payments may be made in installments with the first minimum payment of \$150.00 due by Tuesday April 30, 2024, and the second minimum payment of \$150.00 due by Wednesday May 15, 2024.
- An itemized breakdown of costs will be provided for parents at our first cheer parent meeting on Thursday April 25, 2024.
- Cheerleaders who do not fulfill their financial obligations to the team will be ineligible to participate in cheerleading activities.
- Cheerleaders who have an outstanding balance for cheerleading at GHS from previous seasons are ineligible to tryout until those obligations are satisfied.
- All fundraisers go toward the Gateway High School Cheerleading program. If your cheerleader raises more than the total balance owed, the remainder will used on other cheer necessities (i.e., pregame meals, awards, etc.)
- If a cheerleader is removed or quits the team all funds paid/raised are non-refundable.
- All cheer uniforms are owned by the Gateway High School Athletic Department. Under no circumstance will the cheerleaders be able to keep the uniform. All school issued property not returned at the end of the season will be reported to Fines & Fees. Please refer to the provided *Uniform Checkout Form* for details.

Other Information

Summer practices are essential to the success of our cheer squad. The summer practice schedule will be communicated prior to tryouts. A commitment should be made to attend practice. Any absence from summer practice should be communicated to the coaching staff.

Cheer Camp is mandatory for all members of the GHS Cheerleading Squad. If a cheerleader is unable to attend cheer camp, they will be unable to cheer for GHS. The cheerleading camp dates are June 17– June 19, 2024.
